A third sentencing alternative is the Department of Juvenile Justice (DJJ), which can be considered the institution of last resort for delinquent youths in California. Of the DJJ cases, 10% are there for murder, 17% for robbery, 21% for assaults, 15% for burglary, 14% for drug offenses, and 3% for rape.
