## **Overcoming Poverty and Inequality in South Africa**

Background . In 2013, the World Bank Group announced two goals that would guide its development work worldwide. The first is to end extreme poverty, that is, to bring the number of extremely poor people, defined as those living on less than \$1.90 dollars a day (in 2011 Purchasing Power Parity), to less than 3% of the world population by 2030.
