Often, the approach of educating the individual about his or her place in society and the appropriate "normal" behavior (in other words, the exact goal of psychosocial intervention) is preferable to using drugs to alter an individual's behavior. When non-medical therapy is an option, that is the way to go.

What are Psychosocial Interventions? (with pictures)

Psychosocial interventions were defined as any intervention that emphasizes psychological or social factors rather than biological factors (Ruddy and House, 2005). This definition allows for the inclusion of psychological interventions and health education, as well as interventions with a focus on social aspects, such as social support.
