Select the area of ivy to be removed. Thankfully, it is not necessary to remove all of the ivy on a tree in order to kill it off. The root system of the ivy is in the ground, so you only have to remove the bottom-most section of ivy and the rest will eventually die.

To identify spruce trees, first look at the needles. If they're attached individually to branches, have 4 sides, and roll easily between your fingers, it's a spruce. Then, check the cones, which on spruce trees have smooth, thin scales and are easy to bend. You can also look at the shape of the branches, which will be bushy, full, and upturned if it's a spruce.
