Onomatopoeia is the use of words which sound like their meanings, such as “HISS,” “MURMUR,” “BUZZ,” and so on. A really skillful poet may merely use S-sounds in a poem about a snake, rather than the word “HISS.” WHAT IS IMAGERY Each poem also uses imagery which is produced by figures of speech.
